

## International Conference on Institutionalization of Child Rights in the Digital Future

Istanbul, Turkey, 16-17 October 2014

### ① Administrative Note

We welcome your participation in the **International Conference on Institutionalization of Child Rights in the Digital Future** that will take place in Istanbul, Turkey on 16-17 October 2014 at Istanbul University. This event is being organized to coincide with the twenty-fifth anniversary of the adoption of the UN Convention on the Rights of the Child by the United Nations General Assembly. UNICEF is making use of the anniversary both to celebrate the progress made over the past quarter of a century and to draw attention to outstanding inequity. The goal is to generate new ideas for upholding the rights of children – especially the most disadvantaged, excluded, and vulnerable – in the new and very different era that lies ahead.

The conference is organized in collaboration with the UNICEF CEE/CIS Regional Office, the UNICEF Turkey Country Office, Dublin Institute of Technology and the communications faculties of eleven Turkish universities – namely, Ankara, Anadolu, Bilgi, Gazi, Galatasaray, İstanbul, İstanbul Aydın, Kocaeli, Konya and Mersin.

The Conference will be held at the Istanbul University, Communication Faculty, Conference Hall (Marked as A on the map below)



**Currency & Exchange:**

You can exchange your currency into Turkish Lira (TL) either at the exchange offices of the airport or any exchange office in town. Please also keep in mind that US dollars or Euro currencies in small denominations are accepted generally by taxis, restaurants, and shopping centres in Istanbul.

**Security/Tracking:**

Turkish citizens and foreign visitors alike are required to carry some form of identification at all times such as a passport or driving license. You may be asked to show ID before entering some restaurants/bars. In Istanbul, like in any other cosmopolitan city, be careful of pickpockets in train stations, around money exchange offices, at open markets and stores.

## **Transportation and Accommodation:**

## **Transportation from the Airport to the City:**

**Airport pick-up:** Yanki Travel can provide pick up service and meet participants at the airport. Information related to transportation fee will be communicated upon the requested destination. **Taxi:** You may wish to consider taking authorised yellow coloured taxis with taxi meters (note: the license numbers should be printed on both sides of the car), which are available from the airport at all times. Taxis can request an additional fee for heavy baggage.

**Bus service "HAVATAS":** The buses depart from the Arrivals level of both the International and Domestic terminals at Atatürk Airport to Taksim. Buses leave the airport at 04:00, then every hour until 01:00. The cost is TL10.

You are encouraged to bring your own laptops for personal use.

Please note that this is a green conference. We are minimizing the printed documents. All documents including the admin note and presentations will be delivered to you with a flash drive.

## **Social Programme:**

## **Weather conditions:**

Day temperature in Istanbul in October varies between 14-21 C°.

## **Electrical Current and Appliances:**

The electricity supply in Turkey is 220 volts AC 50 cycles. Electrical appliances must have European plugs, (i.e. round-tipped, two-pinned), an international adapter is very useful.
