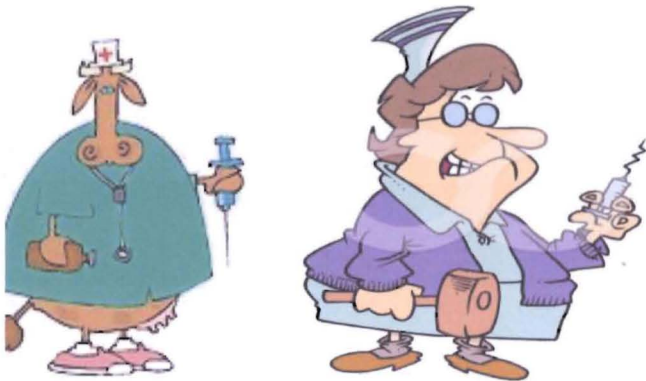


How can these diseases be prevented?

What Are Infectious Diseases?
